### **Camp D Artist's Studio**

*Introduction to an array of techniques, plus drawing/sketching lessons.*

Each child will love to draw with the structure for success and the freedom for creativity found in our Artist's Studio. Through a series of drawing projects, we will explore the basic elements of shape while each artist creates their own masterpiece. Artistic processes will be introduced and practiced so that confidence and flexibility develop. A variety of media will be introduced and available for artists to add finishing touches to their work. Units of study will include drawing basics, drawing from graphics, drawing from a still life, volume drawing, and widening horizons.
