Camp C Sewing Circle

Hand and machine sewing, embroidery, and quilting.

Sewing Circle lessons and projects will inspire and teach each child how to sew, using step-by-step directions, simple language, and child-created examples of contemporary sewing projects. After learning a few basic skills, we will be eager to try out all kinds of sewing projects. Join us this summer if you're ready to "get your stitch on."

During hands-on sewing sessions, we will focus on easy, fun projects that don't require extra work. Intermediate sewers will take these projects to the next level by initiating creative touches and inventive adaptations. All projects can be hand sewn. Because most children are often fascinated by sewing machines, a brief introduction will be provided and those who are ready will have an opportunity to use a sewing machine during our sewing sessions. We will end each session with time for "sew and tell."
